Approval of Regular Minutes from December Council Meeting: A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Troy Stegemoeller to approve minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

Review Payment of Bills for the Month of December: A motion was made by Mandie Moore and seconded by Joe Sisk to approve Bills as presented. Motion passed.

Police Report: Albert presented December stats, which indicated an influx of arrest and incident cases submitted to the DA for prosecution. On Jan. 5<sup>th</sup> David Wilson began his employment with the Idalou PD as the new Lieutenant. Lt. Wilson has approximately 11 years of experience and comes to the IPD from Muleshoe PD where he held the position of Sergeant.

Discuss 2015 Special Election Term Limits and Street Sales Tax: Renee informed the Council we will need to have an election in May to renew the Street Sales Tax. Discuss on adding staggered terms for Council. After much discussion it was decided to add Term limits as well as Street Sales Tax to the Election in May. Terms will go to four and Council with Seniority will have their terms extended if voted for in May.

Update on Downtown Streetlights: The streetlights in downtown have been off for the last month. We have had problems keeping them on and we have our electrician working on the issue now. After the electrician completes his work we will have the ability to turn the lights manually on when needed.

General Fund Strategic Planning Session- Suzette informed the Council that on Feb. 23<sup>rd</sup> from 6-9 they will have a Strategic planning session for Public Safety. This will involve Russ, Chief and Council and Suzette.
