

Regular Council Meeting
Idalou City Council
June 15, 2015

The regular meeting of the Idalou City Council was called to order by Mayor David Riley. Those in attendance were Mayor David Riley, Darrell Fuller, Mandie Moore, Troy Stegemoeller, Joe Tom Sisk, and City Administrator Suzette Williams, Police Chief Albert Garcia, Public Works Director Brian Baumann and City Secretary Renee Wilbanks. Also in attendance were Patrolmen Steve Perez and Bruce Kastning and Heather Keister with Frees and Nichols Engineering Firm.

Approval of Regular Minutes from May Council Meeting: A motion was made by Troy Stegemoeller and seconded by Mandie Moore. Motion passed.

Review Payment of Bills for the Month of May: A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Darrell Fuller. Motion passed.

Questions and Comment from Public: Heather Keister was in attendance with Frees and Nichols Engineering Firm. Heather introduced herself and briefed the Council on what her firm has to offer the City.

Approve COBRA Contract with TMLIEBP: A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Mandie Moore to continue the COBRA contract with TMLIEBP. Motion passed.

Emergency Management Coordinator Report on Active Shooter Exercise Update: Monday June 1st the City of Idalou conducted a full scale emergency exercise to test our response to an active shooter incident at the School. All City departments tested their response plans and we set objectives to evaluate in five core capability areas. There were a total of 54 people present during the exercise from different places. Overall exercise conduct went well and improvement was noted in comparison to our last full scale exercise which was in 2013. Adam felt we had come a long way in preparing for and responding to both small and large emergencies in the past few years, but we also have room for some more improvement. Improvements will be put in place as quickly as possible. A few projects Adam has in place to be working on over the next year or two include; updating the City of Idalou Basic Emergency Management Plan, speaking to the City Administrator about a Continuity of Operations Plan and basic disaster recover considerations, and conducting small scale exercises that meet the needs of our departments. Adam also thanked the Council for allowing the City of Idalou personnel to participate in the June 1st Exercise.

Police Report: Albert presented May stats. The purchase of AR-15's has been completed. The final cost was \$2,984.55. All officers were qualified with the weapons on 6/05/15. The Active Shooter training was completed and the PD was able to identify areas where we excelled and some where they can improve. Chief Thomas Esparza was appointed as the first Chief of Police for the Idalou ISD Police Department. A Memo of Understanding is in progress for both agencies. Hopefully the first draft will be complete by next Council Meeting for review.

Update on Building and Standards Commission Meeting 06.04.15: The Commission ordered demolition in 30 days. New owner has asked for extension.
