

Regular Council Meeting
Idalou City Council
February 5th, 2018

The regular meeting of the Idalou City Council was called to order by Mayor David Riley. Those in attendance were Mayor Pro Tem Troy Stegemoeller, Joe Sisk, Darrell Fuller, Eric Geiser, and Albert Bravo. Approval of Regular Minutes from January Council Meeting, A motion was made by Darrell Fuller and seconded by Albert Bravo to approve January minutes with corrections. Motion passed unanimously.

Approve Bills from January as presented: A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Albert Bravo to approve minutes as presented. Motion passed.

Calling the May 5th General Election: A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Darrell Fuller to call the May 5th General Election for Idalou City Council. Also included was calling the election to be held jointly with cities/schools inside Lubbock County. Approve Joint Elections Contract. Appoint Dorothy Kennedy, Elections Administrator as the Joint Elections Officer. Appoint Dorothy Kennedy Elections Administrator as the Joint Early Voting Clerk. Appoint the Elections Office at 1308 Crickets Avenue as the main early Voting/polling Place. Approve Exhibit A of the Joint Early Voting Schedule and approve April 24th and May 1st as the two 12 hour days of Early voting. Approve exhibit B of the Election day vote centers. Appoint the Supervisor and Rover for each Vote Center for Election Day. Appoint the Early voting Ballot Board Judge and Alt. Judge. Appoint Central Count Station personnel: Dorothy Kennedy, Elections Administrator as Central Count Manager, Roxzine Stinson as Tabulation Supervisor and Tom Grimes as the Central County Presiding Judge. Appoint the following bilingual Election clerks, Gloria Armenta, Rachel Botello and Aaron Frodsham. Motion passed.

Public Works Report: Public Works Troy Herd gave his report.

Financial Report: Suzette presented the Financial Report.

Police Report: David reported statistics from January. David also report on the Racial Profiling report and told the Council he would answer any questions if needed.

Discuss and Consider Amending Ordinance 18-01-01 Chapter 3: A motion was made by Troy Stegemoeller and seconded by Joe Sisk to change wording to Establishing Ordinance 18-01-01 instead of amending. Motion passed.

Discuss and Consider Ordinance 18-02-01 regarding Air Guns: A motion was made by Troy Stegemoeller and seconded by Joe Sisk to approve Ordinance 18-02-01. Motion passed.


