

Regular Council Meeting
Idalou City Council
August 13th, 2018

The regular meeting of the Idalou City Council was called to order by Mayor David Riley. Those in attendance were Mayor Pro Tem Troy Stegemoeller, Darrell Fuller, Eric Geiser, and Albert Bravo. Staff attending the meeting was City Administrator Suzette Williams, Chief David Wilson, Public Works Director Troy Herd, EMC Clint Day and City Secretary Renee Wilbanks. Citizens in attendance were Tiffany Miers, and Rodney Bayliss.

Rodney Bayless requested the Council revisit the alley behind his house and the people leaving from school. They informed him he would be on the September agenda.

Approval of Regular Minutes from July Council Meeting, A motion was made by Darrell Fuller and seconded by Eric Geiser to approve May minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

Approve Bills from July as presented: A motion was made by Albert Bravo and seconded by Troy Stegemoeller to approve bills as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Public Works Report: Troy Herd presented the water report for July.

Police Report: David presented July Stats. David attended Mental Health Peace Officer Certification school this past month and passed the state exam on July 20th. Officer Shaw is doing well in FTO program and should be released the first part of September.

Financial Report: Suzette presented the Financial Report.

Update on TCEQ Petroleum Site: Suzette has been in touch with TCEQ to receive guidance in cleaning up abandon gas stations. TCEQ contacted the City to notify us that the Duncan gas station is no longer in compliance and is under enforcement. Duncan has currently been fined approximately \$10,000.00 for being out of compliance during the last inspection. A staff attorney with TCEQ should contact Suzette in the next week or two to discuss in depth the process that TCEQ will take on the property.

Discuss Speeding on East 7th: Two years ago council discussed speeding on East 7th. A four way stop was added to the intersection of E. 7th and Pecan. Speeding continues to be a problem in this area. After some discussion Chief was instructed to get a sign that states the speed the car is traveling at and patrol the area and see if this slows people down.

Discuss and Consider Utility Bill Request from 403 Walnut: Tiffany Miers was present to request the Council to reduce her bill after her water bill showed a very large usage. Tiffany states they had not leak at this time. After some discussion it was decided to send the meter off for checking and revisit when we have the findings.

Discuss and Consider Wildcat Development Phase 2-4 Drainage: There was some discussion but no decisions were made at this time.

Discuss and Consider Justice Assistance Grant Resolution 18-08-01: A motion was made by Darrell Fuller and seconded by Eric Geiser. Motion passed.

Discuss and Consider Development of BLK D7 SEC 41 AB 400 TR 6A of NE/4 of RR AC: 29.957: No one was in attendance to discuss.

Discuss and Consider Street Closures for Idalou Cotton Fest September 21st and 22nd: Request to close same streets as last year: Walnut St. from 10th to 7th


10th Street from Walnut to Main
