

Regular Council Meeting
Idalou City Council
October 8th, 2018

The regular meeting of the Idalou City Council was called to order by Mayor David Riley. Those in attendance were Mayor Pro Tem Troy Stegemoeller, Darrell Fuller, Eric Geiser, Joe Tom Sisk and Albert Bravo. Staff attending the meeting was City Administrator Suzette Williams, Chief David Wilson, Patrolman Brandt Donathon, Patrolman Miguel Guerrero, Public Works Director Troy Herd, and City Secretary Renee Wilbanks. Roger Sage with the Cemetery Board was also in attendance.

A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Albert Bravo to approve Regular and Special minutes. Motion passed.

Approve Bills from September as presented: A motion was made by Troy Stegemoeller and seconded by Joe Sisk to approve bills as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Public Works Report: Troy Herd presented the water report for September.

Police Report: David presented the September stats. David introduced Brandt Donathon our new Officer.

Financial Report: Suzette presented the financial report. Suzette also stated we would receive a \$5,000.00 increase in payment from EMS.

Discuss Request from Idalou Cemetery Board to Acquire Cemetery and Operations of Cemetery: Roger Sage addressed the Council regarding taking over the cemetery. He stated the Board is almost nonexistent and Tronda and Jack don't have the time to meet with people to take care of this anymore. After discussion it was decided Suzette was to talk to different people to get more information as to how this would affect the City and if this is even feasible. This will be addressed at a later Council meeting.

Discuss and Consider Accepting Bid for Ground Tank Interior Painting: Water Tower Maintenance bid \$49,000.00 to paint the ground tank. If we accept their bid we do not have to go out for a sealed bid because the others exceed \$50,000.00. A motion was made by Troy Stegemoeller and seconded by Albert Bravo to go with Water Tower Maintenance to paint the storage tank. Motion passed.

Discuss and Consider Purchase of Dumpsters: A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Eric Geiser to spend \$50,000.00 on new dumpsters. Motion passed.

Discuss and Consider Awarding Request for Qualifications for Engineers on Downtown Revitalization Project (DPR): A motion was made by Darrell Fuller and seconded by Eric Geiser to award the Engineering DPR project to Brandt Engineers. Motion passed.

Discuss and Consider Resolution 18-10-01 Approving an Application for Funding through TDA DRP: A motion was made by Darrell Fuller and seconded by Joe Sisk to approve the Resolution 18-10-01. Approving the application for funding through TDA DRP. Motion passed.

Discuss and Consider Resolution 18-10-02 Establishing the Designated Downtown Area as Slum or Blighted: A motion made by Troy Stegemoeller and seconded by Joe Sisk to approve Resolution 18-10-02 establishing the designated downtown area as Slum or Blighted. Motion passed.

Discuss and Consider Awarding the Request for Proposal Depository: A motion was made by Darrell Fuller and seconded by Joe Sisk to award depository to Vista Bank. Motion passed with Troy Stegemoeller recused.

Discuss and Consider Re-Adopting Ordinance 07-06-02 "Curfew": A motion was made by Troy Stegemoeller and seconded by Eric Geiser to re-adopt Ordinance 07-06-02 curfew ordinance. Motion passed.

Discuss and Consider Acceptance of MIMOSA LANE L 16 THRU 19 from Mr. Peebles: A motion was made by Troy Stegemoeller and seconded by Albert Bravo to accept the property from Mr. Peebles if it has a clear title. Motion passed.

Discuss and Consider Acceptance of Final Plat for ROSS BLK 22 TR C & TR 4-A-C OF BLK D-7 SEC 41- To be Divided into three lots: A motion was made by Eric Geiser and seconded by Darrell Fuller to accept the final plat. Motion passed.

Discuss Wildcat Estate Development Drainage: A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Albert Bravo to table. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Troy Stegemoeller and seconded by Joe Sisk to go into Executive Session.
