The regular meeting of the Idalou City Council was called to order by Mayor David Riley. Also on April 4<sup>th</sup> the department presented their CJAC grant. The department was ranked number four out of twelve departments. We will be fully funded for the purchase of a 2020 Ford Police Interceptor SUV.

Russ presented both the quarterly EMS and Fire Report.


Suzette presented the Financial Report

Discuss and Consider Ordinance 19-04-02 Prohibiting Smoking on City Property: A motion was made by Troy Stegemoeller and seconded by Erick Geiser to approve Ordinance with changes of smoking will be allowed in Parking lot. Motion passed.

Discuss and Consider Employee Utility Bill Credit: City Administrator, Suzette Williams, brought before council a written policy for the employee utility bill credit. The written policy is requesting that employees regardless of position receive a \$90.00 a month utility bill credit; this is an increase from current credits given. After discussion a motion was made by Eric Geiser and seconded by Joe Sisk to approve the 90.00 credit. Motion passed with Troy Stegemoeller voting against.
