
Discuss and Consider Variance Request Setback at 826 Hickory: A request by the homeowner to reduce the setback requirements to allow for carport to be installed. A motion was made by Eric Geiser to allow the setback as long as the carport does not protrude pass the sidewalk and seconded by Albert Bravo. Motion carried unanimously.

Discuss Proposal Letter submitted by Kelly Jack regarding property at legal description BLK D7 SEC 41 AB 400 TR 6A of NE/4 of RR AC 29.957. Council reviewed the letter submitted by Kelly Jack regarding his intention to purchase the property west of the Dollar General. Council welcomes the opportunity to work with Kelly Jack and wishes him well with his development.

Discuss and Consider Approving Development Plans for BLK D7 SEC 41 AB 400 PT NW/4 ACS: 114,436 Known as Sunset Manor; Property Outside City Limits. After discussion, a motion was made by Troy Stegemoeller to table the decision until the City Administrator contacts Underwood Law Firm and seconded by Joe Sisk. Motion carried unanimously.
