



## **IDALOU MUNICIPAL COURT DRESS CODE**

All persons entering the Courtroom must be clean, neat, and dressed appropriately so as to maintain the dignity, decorum and professional atmosphere of the Court and the administration of Justice.

**THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION SHOULD SERVE AS A *GUIDE* ON THE CLOTHING THAT IS CONSIDERED INAPPROPRIATE OR UNACCEPTABLE FOR COURT:**

Shorts, capris, pants that are tattered or have holes in them, tank tops, halter tops, mid-drift exposing tops, muscle shirts, sleeveless shirts, cutoff shirts, caps, hats, do-rags, sunglasses, clothing that displays offensive, vulgar, racist, gang related, obscene language and/or graphics, dresses/skirts that are more than two (2) inches above the knee, clothing that exposes undergarments.

*Any person not dressed in appropriate Courtroom attire is subject to removal.*
