The special meeting of the Idalou City Council was called to order by Mayor Russ Perkins. Those in attendance were Mayor Russ Perkins, Albert Bravo, Kyle DuBois, Joe Sisk, Brendi Pierce and Darrell Fuller. Staff in attendance, were City Administrator Suzette Williams.

Discuss and Consider Approving 2022-2023 Interlocal Agreement Between Lubbock County and City of Idalou Volunteer Fire Department for Fire Suppression and Rescue Services. As Fire Chief, Russ Perkins noted that the amount of \$72,540.00 is less than previous years. The county is no longer paying for calls within the city limits, they are now calculating each run at \$650.00. The cost of \$650.00 per call is below the actual cost to run a call; this number was determined by the Lubbock County Commissioners. Fire Chief Russ Perkins along with other Fire Chiefs in Lubbock County will continue to work towards a higher per call calculation.
