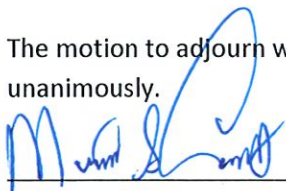

Financial Report: City Administrator Suzette Williams reported that the EDC has \$333,684.06 as of 12.31.23

Discuss and Consider Idalou ISD Grant Application. EDC has received a grant request from Idalou ISD in the amount of 2,126.50 to fund an ECG machine and an ECG Utility Cart. This equipment will add to the current equipment provided by the school. Students completing the course will obtain their Patient Care Technician license and will be able to work immediately after graduation. A motion to fund the grant application was made by Troy Stegemoeller and seconded by Brendi Pierce. Motion passed unanimously.
