

Regular City Council Meeting

February 9th, 2026

The regular meeting of the Idalou City Council was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Mayor Russ Perkins in the Council Chambers at 301 Main Street, Idalou, Texas.

Consider and Approve the Regular Meeting Minutes from January 2026: A motion was made by Kyle DuBois and seconded by Brendi Pierce to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes from January 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion and Possible Action on the Final Plat for Lots 1-24 and Tract A of the Brana Estates Subdivision: A motion was made by Kyle DuBois and seconded by Brendi Pierce to approve the Final Plat, contingent upon the favorable recommendation from the City Engineer. No permits will be issued until all approved. Motion passed unanimously.
