Consider and Approve the Regular Meeting Minutes from November 2025: A motion was made by Kyle DuBois and seconded by Joe Sisk to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes from November 2025. Motion carried unanimously.

Consider and Approve the Special Meeting Minutes from December 2025: A motion was made by Albert Bravo and seconded by Darrell Fuller to approve the Special Meeting Minutes from December 2025. Motion carried unanimously.

Discuss the Demolition of the Existing Water Tower and Suggestions for Use: Council directed Suzette Williams to proceed with the demolition as presented.

Discuss and Consider an Ordinance of the City of Idalou, Texas Amending Article 12.05 Concerning Small Motor and Electric Vehicles: A motion was made by Brendi Pierce and seconded by Joe Sisk to adopt the ordinance amending Article 12.05. Motion carried unanimously.

Discuss and Consider an Ordinance of the City of Idalou, Texas Regulating Golf Carts Within the Limits of the City of Idalou, Texas: A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Darrell Fuller to deny the proposed ordinance regulating golf carts. The motion failed, with Brendi Pierce, Kyle DuBois, and Albert Bravo voting against the motion.

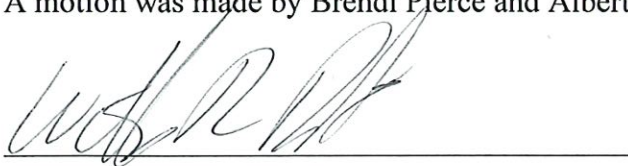
