

Special City Council Meeting & Budget Workshop

Idalou City Council

June 30, 2026

The Special Meeting and Budget Workshop of the Idalou City Council was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Russ Perkins in the Council Chambers at 301 Main Street, Idalou, Texas.

Those in attendance were Mayor Russ Perkins; Mayor Pro Tem Joe Sisk; Councilmembers Darrell Fuller, Brendi Pierce, and Kyle Dubois. Councilmember Albert Bravo was absent.

Action Items

1. Discussion and Possible Action to Approve an Interlocal Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Between the City of Idalou and the City of Plainview for Cooperative Purchasing Services.

A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Kyle Dubois to approve the Interlocal Cooperative Purchasing Agreement. Motion carried unanimously.

2. Discussion and Possible Action to Authorize the Sale and Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages During the Cotton Fest 2026 Street Dance, Including Authority for the City Administrator to Approve a Rescheduled Event Date Occurring Within the 2026 Calendar Year if Necessary Due to Weather or Public Safety Concerns.

A motion was made by Kyle Dubois and seconded by Darrell Fuller to authorize the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages during the Cotton Fest 2026 Street Dance and authorize the City Administrator to approve a rescheduled event date within the 2026 calendar year, if necessary due to weather or public safety concerns. Motion carried unanimously with Councilmember Brendi Pierce recusing herself from the vote.

Executive Session

A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Brendi Pierce to convene into Executive Session pursuant to Texas Government Code §551.074 (Personnel Matters) to deliberate personnel matters concerning a City employee. Motion carried unanimously.

Reconvene into Open Session

The City Council reconvened into Open Session. A motion was made by Brendi Pierce and seconded by Darrell Fuller to reconvene into Open Session. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Joe Sisk and seconded by Darrell Fuller to authorize the City Administrator to offer a severance agreement to a City employee. Motion carried unanimously.

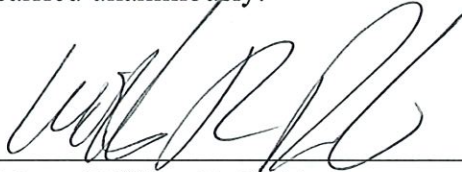
Budget Workshop
